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Motivation

- Inequality and Redistribution
 - ▶ Relevance: Redistribution → Inequality
 - ▶ Inequality → Redistribution?
 - Relation not as expected
 - Relevant Internationally + South Africa
- What determines demand for redistribution?
 - ▶ Role of information → Kuziemko et al. 2013
 - Puzzle
 - Information affects concern for inequality but not policy preferences
 - Missing element?

Contribution


- ▶ Our argument → Missing element is mobilization
- What we do → Survey experiment
 - Survey in two Cape Town townships (1,600 obs)
 - Treatments
 - ▶ Info on local inequality → Replicate Kuziemko et al. 2013
 - International info + videos (mobilization)
 - Outcomes
 - Ask about inequality concern + redistributive policy preferences
 - ▶ Action → send sms to local councillor/ sign petition
- Second wave to be done


