

Queries and responses on the request for research proposals

## Macro-fiscal analysis and policy modelling

- Q.1 Does the research proposal need to combine both fiscal policy and monetary policy? Can the research proposal's topic be either fiscal policy or monetary policy?
- A.1 Research proposals can focus on either fiscal policy or monetary policy or combine both.
- Q.2 Are researchers required to hold a postgraduate degree or equivalent to be eligible for submitting a research proposal?
- A.2 No. There is no specific requirement that the author must hold a postgraduate degree or equivalent to submit a research proposal. Each proposal will be reviewed for scientific merit and feasibility. Proposals will be selected on the basis of three criteria: (i) relevance to the research project, (ii) strength of empirical and policy contributions, and (iii) quality and clarity of writing. Preference will be given to applications from early-career and female scholars, as well as researchers from South Africa.
- Q.3 How many proposals can be submitted by a researcher?
- A.3 A researcher is allowed to submit more than one proposal. However, one submission is for one proposal. Therefore, please submit the proposals separately for the ease of tracking and assessing.
- Q.4 Is there any restriction on the researcher's country of origin?
- A.4 No. There is no restriction on the researcher's country of origin. However, preference will be given to applications from early-career and female scholars, as well as researchers from South Africa.
